
Calcutta's now Kolkata's unique mix of Cultures and Festivals are for everyone to celebrate. This is what makes the city so special.

The Society **CARES** for the less fortunate and marginalised individuals of the community in Kolkata, **Caring** for the aged, young people and those with a special need, **Assisting** by being available in times of crisis, **Reaffirming** the dignity of each individual and **Encouraging** each one to face life's challenges.

CAISS has been involved in meeting the immediate needs of the community by providing assistance, for the aged in the form of rations, medicals and a monthly pension. For the children & young people, CAISS supports their education in the form of fees, books, school charges, boarding fees, uniform, tiffin and transport expenses. For those who need a steady income, the Society assists in finding suitable jobs, providing jobs skills training and micro loans to setup small scale enterprises.





Registration





Logistics


